Chapter/Squadron EAA Air Academy Reservation Information



EAA Chapters have been at the heart of EAA Air Academy's success since it began in 1984. For many of the youth who have participated, it has become a stepping stone for both their personal growth and development, as well as their appreciation for aviation. As the success of Air Academy has grown, it becomes more important than ever to make a reservation early. Openings are filled on a first come, first served basis, so to assure that your Academy candidate has the opportunity to attend, please follow the reservation procedures.

2010 EAA Air Academy Reservation Procedures

1. To reserve a place in a specific session of the 2010 EAA Air Academy, you must complete the Reservation and Deposit Form on this mailer and send it to us with the appropriate deposit amount by March 31, 2010. The deposit is applied toward the registration fee. Please submit a separate form and deposit check for each reservation. **Please do not make travel arrangements until your candidate has been accepted.**
2. Please include a copy of this form with the chosen candidate's participant application (available at www.airacademy.org), the participant's letter of application, and two letters of reference. These are due no later than 60 days before the start of camp.
3. If the candidate is also seeking financial assistance through an EAA scholarship, an application can be downloaded from www.airacademy.org and sent along with the participant application. **The combination of money they request through the scholarship and Young Eagles credit can only equal half the cost of the camp.** Scholarship funding is not guaranteed.
4. If you wish to cancel your reservation before the 60 day deadline date, you can request a refund by letter, fax, or email or offer it as a donation to the EAA Air Academy.
5. Full payment and all participant forms, including travel arrangements and health forms, are due no later than 30 days before the start of camp. These additional forms will be mailed to the students once they are accepted to the Air Academy.
