As you finalize your plans, we are including a few reminders for ALL Ultralight exhibitors.

Running of engines **without a prop** in the Ultralight Exhibits is authorized, subject to approval by the Exhibit Office. The operation must not negatively affect other exhibitors.

<u>Ultralight Exhibitors participating in N-numbered aircraft demo flights</u> <u>or two-place Ultralight trainer introductory flight lessons:</u>

- 1. Any form of compensation for aircraft rides/Ultralight introductory flight lessons is strictly prohibited.
- 2. All passengers must correctly complete and sign the EAA Waiver Forms.
- 3. Helmets must be worn by both occupants during two place flights.
- Please list below all pilots that will be flying your aircraft or Ultralight during AirVenture 2020. All pilots must be prepared to show proper credentials for the type of aircraft or Ultralight trainer they will be flying.
