**CERTIFICATE OF WAIVER OR AUTHORIZATION:**

**I have read and/or been briefed on the Certificate of Waiver or Authorization and all its' special provisions and fully understand the procedures, requirements and limitations of this document.**

- 1) It is EAA Warbirds of America policy that each aircraft participating in an officially sanctioned EAA air show have a minimum of \$1,000,000 Liability insurance including air show fly-by coverage.
- 2) No person shall occupy an aircraft at an official EAA Warbirds of America Air Show other than pilot and required crew members specified by the Aircraft Flight Manual, or as approved by the FAA.
- 3) Pilot in Command of each performing aircraft in an official EAA Warbirds of America Air Show shall have a minimum of 100 flying hours as PIC of the aircraft type to be flown in the air show or 25 hours in type and not less than 300 hours as PIC of warbird or high performance aircraft.
- 4) No pilot shall participate in a formation flight at an official EAA Warbirds of America Air Show unless the pilot has satisfactorily completed the FAST Formation Qualification Program.
- 5) All aircraft which participate in official EAA Warbirds of America Air Shows will have operable two-way communications equipment and be equipped with a parachute in accordance with FAA regulations.
- 6) It is strongly suggested that all crew members participating in official EAA Warbirds of America Air Shows wear appropriate safety equipment which shall include, as a minimum, helmets and fire retardant flight suits.

I HAVE READ, UNDERSTAND AND WILL COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE STATEMENTS AND AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS EAA, EAA Warbirds of America and EAA Airventure. I CERTIFY THAT I AM QUALIFIED TO ACT AS PIC IN THIS AIRCRAFT.
