

Timeless Voices Informative Research Project

Grade Levels

9-12

Objective: Use video interviews available on EAA's website and other reputable sources to create an informative piece with intentional choices made in relation to audience, tone, formatting, and delivery to effectively communicate the author's ideas.

Choose a video that you are interested in and develop an informative article discussing the person and their contributions, or delve more into an event or time period that the subject spoke about.

Points of Summative Assessment

- 1. Use of reliable sources, including electronic and interviews, to research the selected topic.
- 2. Proper MLA citation of selected sources within the piece and on the works cited page.
- 3. Effective use of an introduction and conclusion that matches audience and purpose.
- 4. Organization of the body or main content that makes it easy for users to understand the intended information, including purposeful formatting choices (lists, footnotes, etc.).
- 5. Purposeful integration of images/charts/graphs to clarify, further, or communicate the purpose and information of the piece.
- 6. Article is between **750** and **1,000** words.
