



Preflight Checklist

Directions: Start at the cockpit (pilot's seat) and begin the preflight moving counterclockwise, ending back at starting point.

1. Look inside cockpit, check that all switches are OFF

Left Side

2. Wing- Leading Edge
3. Sump Fuel- Check for water and contaminants
4. Inspect pitot tube for obstruction
5. Aileron- check for free movement
6. Lights/Wing Tip
7. Tire/Gear
8. Tightness of exposed screws and rivets

Tail Section

9. Tail section- Check tension on all wires
10. Elevator- check for free movement
11. Rudder- check for free movement

Right Side

12. Tightness of exposed screws and rivets
13. Tire/Gear
14. Aileron, check for free movement
15. Lights/Wing Tip
16. Wing- Leading Edge
17. Sump Fuel- Check for water and contaminants

Engine/Front

18. Inspect front of engine, look for obstructions
19. Inspect engine, see that connections are tight
20. Check oil level with dipstick
21. Sump Fuel- Check for water and contaminants
22. Inspect propeller for damage, nicks, etc.
23. Nose wheel
24. Return to left side of cockpit, enter aircraft and check controls for movement of ailerons, elevator, and rudder.
