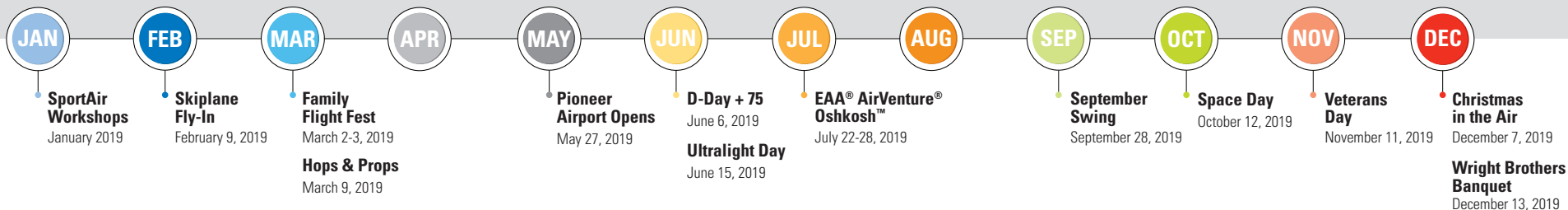

PARTICIPATE

> PIONEER AIRPORT

During the summer season, visitors can experience firsthand the excitement of flying in historic aircraft including a 1929 open-cockpit biplane departing from its plush grass runway. Flights can be purchased the day of and youths ages 8-17 can experience a Young Eagles flight in a Glastar aircraft for free with a waiver co-signed by their parent or legal guardian.

> POBEREZNY PROPERTY TOUR

The 9-acre grounds that EAA founders Paul and Audrey Poberezny once called home is now on display. The tour includes unique access to various rooms, personal memorabilia from a lifetime in aviation, and the beautiful grounds and memorial garden.

> KIDVENTURE GALLERY

This highly interactive area is designed for the younger museum visitors to link aviation's historic past with its exciting future. KidVenture features 16 hands-on exhibits, a scenic overlook from the Tower of Flight, and young people can climb into the cockpit of a half-scale model of an F-22.

> AVIATION ADVENTURE SPEAKER SERIES

This series brings a variety of historic aviation experiences to life each month. Learn from passionate aviators who have unique stories to tell.

> SKYSCAPE THEATER ROYALE

Travel back in time and experience a series of classic aviation films. The museum's Skyscape Theater features an intimate setting with a 50-foot screen and state-of-the-art projection and sound system.

> EDUCATION PROGRAMS

From school groups to scout programs, the museum is an ideal environment for a range of ages and group sizes to have fun while learning. EAA staff members use engaging teaching methods and aviation-themed lessons to meet education objectives or pursue aviation merit badges.

> TOUR GROUPS

Guided museum tours are available for groups of 10 or more and include the movie *Oshkosh: The Spirit of Aviation* narrated by Harrison Ford.

> YOUTH CAMPS

Unforgettable aviation memories at EAA's weeklong camps and overnights designed to introduce young people to the aviation world. Participants explore aviation through technical and learning classrooms as well as hands-on activities with the guidance of knowledgeable instructors and mentors.
