






Batten Board Room

Rental includes screen and projector.












Computer Lab



For groups of more than 300, additional aircraft movement fees may apply. Additional rental may be needed for 500+ people.













Exhibit Hangars








Fergus Chapel










Fergus Plaza






Founders' Wing

Dedicated to preserving EAA's heritage and culture for future generations, the Founders' Wing highlights EAA's significant accomplishments throughout its history.

The main floor can accommodate up to 400, surrounding your guests with the history of EAA's annual convention, AirVenture, through the years. An intimate atmosphere awaits on the mezzanine level where your guests can enjoy viewing the Founders' Library and the EAA Legacy Wall while overlooking suspended aircraft, aviation artwork, and displays. 






Leadership Classroom

Leeward Plaza










Museum








Museum Lobby








Nature Center






Vette Theater
