

EAA's Youth Protection Policy and Program

Implementation Plan for Young Eagle Coordinators and Field Representatives

Goal: Make sure your volunteers are in compliance with EAA's Youth Protection Policy

Due Date: May 1, 2016

IMPORTANT: The background check typically will take two weeks to process. Therefore, please make sure all Young Eagles pilots complete the online training course and background check at least two weeks prior to your Young Eagles events.

January

- Become familiar with the new policy at www.EAA.org/YouthProtection
- Complete the online training course and background check yourself

February/March

- Talk to your Young Eagles pilots and encourage them to take the training
- Talk to your ground volunteers and encourage them to take the training (optional)

April

- Visit www.EAA.org/MemberLookUp and review which of your chapter's Young Eagles pilots and ground volunteers have completed the training: You will need their EAA member # and last name to use the lookup tool
- Contact those volunteers who still need to complete the training and background check

May 1

- All pilots have completed training
- Two-deep volunteer coverage in place (even if someone is sick/unavailable)
- At least two weeks prior to a Young Eagles rally, new volunteer pilots will have to complete the training and background check
- Young Eagles registration forms will not be accepted for flights completed after May 1, 2015, by pilots who have not met the requirements of EAA's Youth Protection Policy and Program
